PARK PERMIT INFORMATION

ALL COVID-19 NYS/CDC REGULATIONS AT THE TIME OF PERMIT MUST BE ENFORCED

Groups of 15 or more people must have a permit.

Restrooms are only open during permit hours.

YOU MUST FIRST CREATE AN ACCOUNT ON OUR WEBSITE LISTED BELOW:

KING MEMORIAL PARK

4030 Split Rock Road, Camillus, NY 13031

King Park is a twenty-acre park located on Split Rock Road, featuring athletic fields, small shade shelter (not for rent), beach volleyball court, pickle ball, tennis and basketball courts, playground area, grills, pavilion and restrooms. The permit accommodates up to 100 people.

KELLEY BROTHERS MEMORIAL PARK

251 Dorwin Avenue, Syracuse, NY 13205

Kelley Park is a fifteen-acre park located on Dorwin Avenue. A new pavilion and benches have been added, along with an accessible walkway to the new pavilion. The park also has a restroom, play areas, tennis court, beach volleyball and grills. There is a small pavilion (not for rent) near the playground equipment to provide shade and picnic seating for all the families that utilize the play areas on a regular basis. **A new playground area is expected to be completed in 2021.** The permit accommodates up to 75 people.

HOWLETT HILL PARK

5051 Youth Center Road, Marcellus, NY 13108

Howlett Hill Park is a nine-acre park located on Youth Center Road off Howlett Hill Road, featuring athletic fields, two softball fields, a tennis court, a basketball court, a covered shelter, grills, playground area, and restrooms. **New playground pieces were added in 2020.** The permit accommodates up to 75 people.

ANTHONY J. SANTARO MEMORIAL PARK

4979 Velasko Road, Syracuse, NY 13215

Santaro Park is a twenty-two-acre park, located on Velasko Road, featuring tennis and basketball courts, athletic fields, playground areas, pavilion, grills, blue shade shelter (not for rent), in-line skate & bike path and restrooms. The permit accommodates up to 150 people.

TOWN RESIDENTS: Can apply exclusively for park use from April 1 – May 1, 2021

Proof of residency REQUIRED at the time of application. (Ex: driver's license, utility bill, checks w/printed address)

TOWN OF ONONDAGA PARK RULES

VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN FOREITURE OF SECURITY DEPOSIT

NO alcoholic beverages allowed in parks.

ALL TRASH IS TO BE "CARRIED OUT."

Vehicles must be left in parking lots - NO driving is permitted to pavilions *unless necessary for a caterer,*

with prior approval. The caterer is required to provide a certificate of insurance naming the Town of Onondaga as additional insured.

Snowmobiles, mini-bikes, golf carts and ATVs are prohibited.

NO open fires, except in designated grills.

NO food or drink on court surfaces....NO glass bottles/containers.

NO DOGS allowed.

Permit hours: 9AM-7:00PM with a Maximum of 8 hours

Vehicles left in the park and locked in can be removed the next morning at 9:00 AM

Your permit DOES NOT give you exclusive rights to the whole park! Respect other groups in the park

using the facilities.

The applicant will be charged for any damages/loss.

Absolutely NO loud music or anything utilizing speakers at any time.

Our parks are located in residential areas and we will respect the rights of our residents.

NO inflatable apparatus or dunk tanks allowed.

NO pony rides/horseback riding allowed.

NO additional grills (gas or charcoal) are allowed to be brought in.

NO generators or unauthorized use of power cords

NO *staked* tents...pop-up gazebo types are acceptable.

Ongoing field use (more than one time) is not issued to non-resident status teams.

Do not use table confetti, staples or thumbtacks for table covers.
