

## Information for Summer Playground programs

- 1) Children who are sick, or who have tested positive for covid-19 need to STAY HOME. It is imperative that you take the utmost precaution that we are not needlessly exposing children to any type of illness. An outbreak at our facilities would not only shut us down for the summer, but could be a serious health risk to children and their families.
- 2) Children will be placed in groups BY AGE (some exceptions for children close in age living in the same household) and will be kept separate from other groups for all 6 weeks of playgrounds. They will be with the same staff members for the duration of the program as well.
- 3) Mask wearing WILL NOT be required to attend camp, but we will ask parents to pack a mask for their children in the event that groups must shelter together in bad weather and/or emergency situations.
  - a. If you would like your children to wear a mask during program that is OK. Please make sure staff is made aware of this when you drop your child off the first day.
- 4) HAND WASHING/SANATIZING will be required for kids upon arrival, before lunch, and periodically throughout the day.
- 5) Drop off time begins at 9:30 AM.
  - a. Children may be dropped off at any point during the day.
- 6) Children must be picked up no later than 2:00 PM
  - a. You may pick up your child early, but please let the staff know at the beginning of the day so they are aware and can be prepared for your child to be picked up.
- 7) Drop off will be at a designated table near the restroom buildings at each park.
  - a. While waiting to check in your child, please stay spread out in line.
- 8) At drop off, parents will check in their child for the day, and MAY NOT follow/help carry their children's belongings to the pavilion. This is done for a number of reasons, but the primary purpose being; keeping contact with people not affiliated with specific groups to a minimum.
- 9) At pick up time, parents will need to wait away from the pavilions, where we will assist you in retrieving your child at the end of the day. We ask that parents do not linger at drop off or pick up and practice social distancing while dropping off/picking up your child.
- 10) We ask that if you, your children, or anyone in your household tests positive for Covid-19, you inform us as soon as possible so we can inform other parents that their children may have been exposed.
- 11) If someone in your household tests positive for covid-19, your child will need to stay home from playgrounds for 2-weeks, or have a negative test result no older than 72 hours before returning to the program.

Please make sure your children have the following each day at their playgrounds:

- Packed lunch and snack
- Full water bottle (re-usable bottles are best)
- Sunblock
- Bug spray (optional)
- Sneakers (NO open-toed shoes, sandals or flip-flops)
- At least 1 mask
- Medications
  - If your child needs to keep medication ON SITE. Please hand it to the playground supervisor on your first day.
  - Explaining the purpose and proper usage of medications to the supervisor is also advised.
  - The medication will be kept in the first aid kit.
